

FY 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program Amendments March – May 2023

The following is a detailed list of proposed changes to the Saint Cloud Area Planning Organization's (APO's) fiscal years (FY) 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Given the nature of some of these changes, an amendment process to this document has been initiated. Per guidelines documented in the APO's Stakeholder Engagement Plan (SEP), a 30-day public comment period is required before changes can be implemented.

The APO's Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) – a committee of area planners and engineers – will review these changes at its meeting on April 27, 2023. The APO's Policy Board is anticipated to act on these changes at its regularly scheduled May meeting (May 11, 2023).
