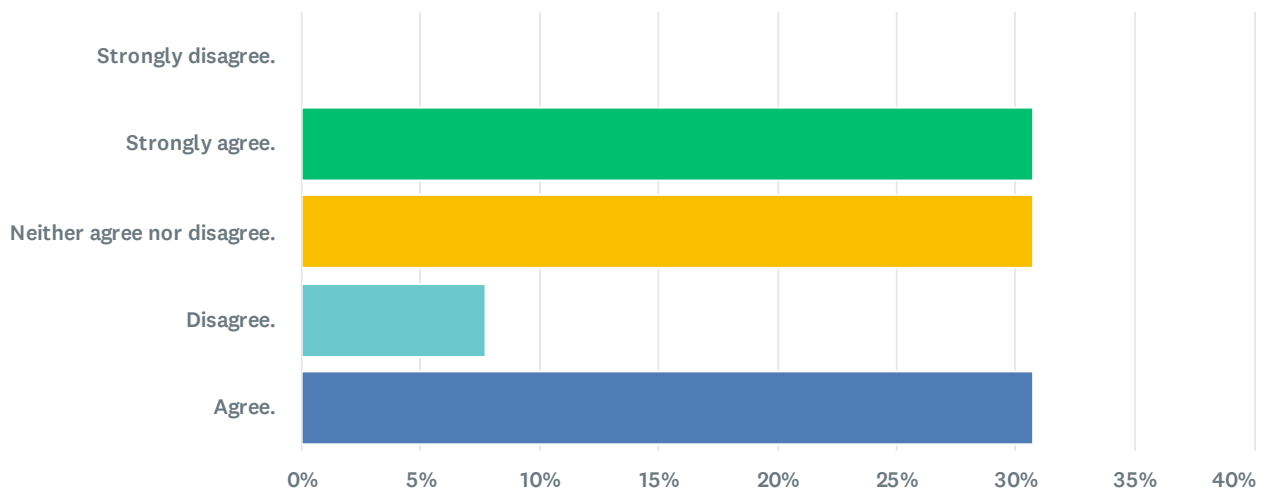


**Q1 Saint Cloud Metro Bus is proposing to REPLACE the mobile data computers in 36 of its Dial-a-Ride buses. In addition, the transit commission is seeking to add an additional two devices as spares. Mobile data computers (MDCs) are essentially an i-Pad-like device that are used to help bus operators keep track of their passengers, destinations, and other important information needed to complete their routes. In total, Metro Bus is anticipating spending \$140,000 in 2026 to upgrade the MDCs. The transit commission is slated to receive \$112,000 in federal funding to complete this project, with the remaining \$28,000 coming from local funding sources. 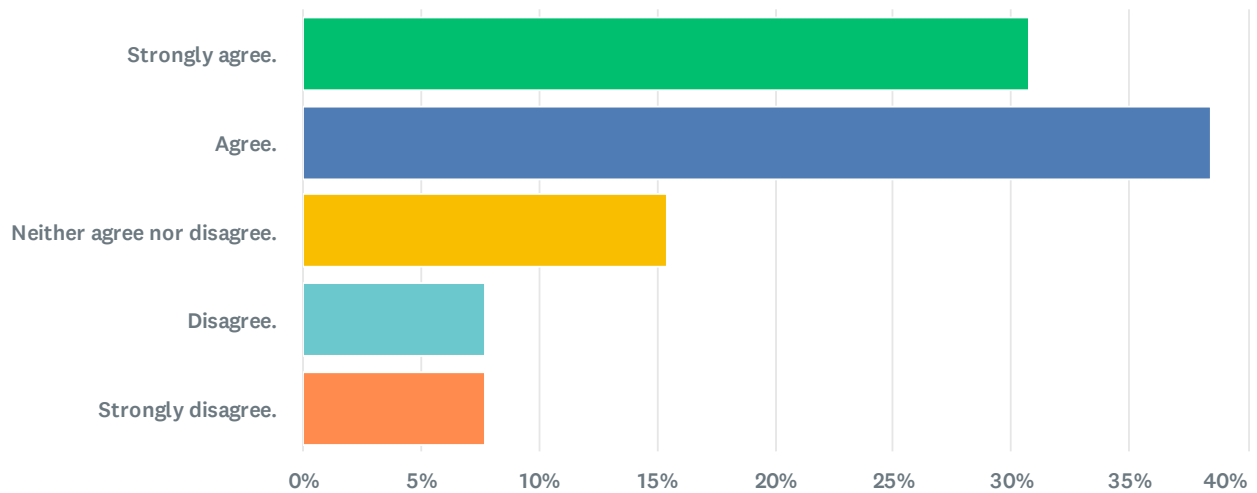

Q2 Saint Cloud Metro Bus is proposing to ADD route designation signage to 36 of its Dial-a-Ride buses. These signs are the digital signs located on the vehicle's exterior that let people know the route/destination the transit vehicle is headed. In total, Metro Bus is anticipating spending \$135,000 in 2026 to add these signs to its paratransit fleet. The transit commission is slated to receive \$108,000 in federal funding to complete this project, with the remaining \$27,000 coming from local funding sources. 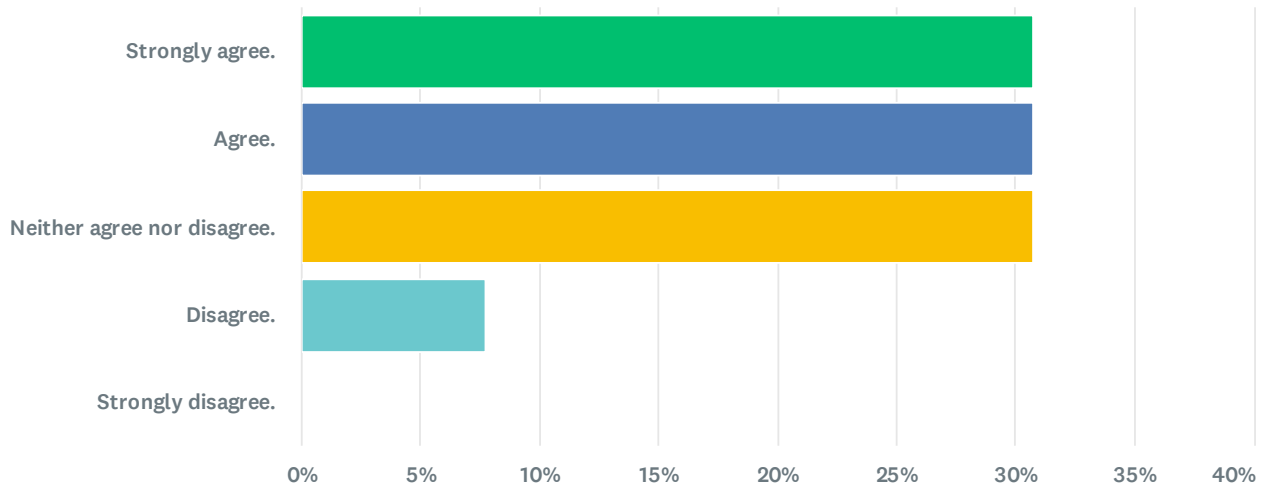

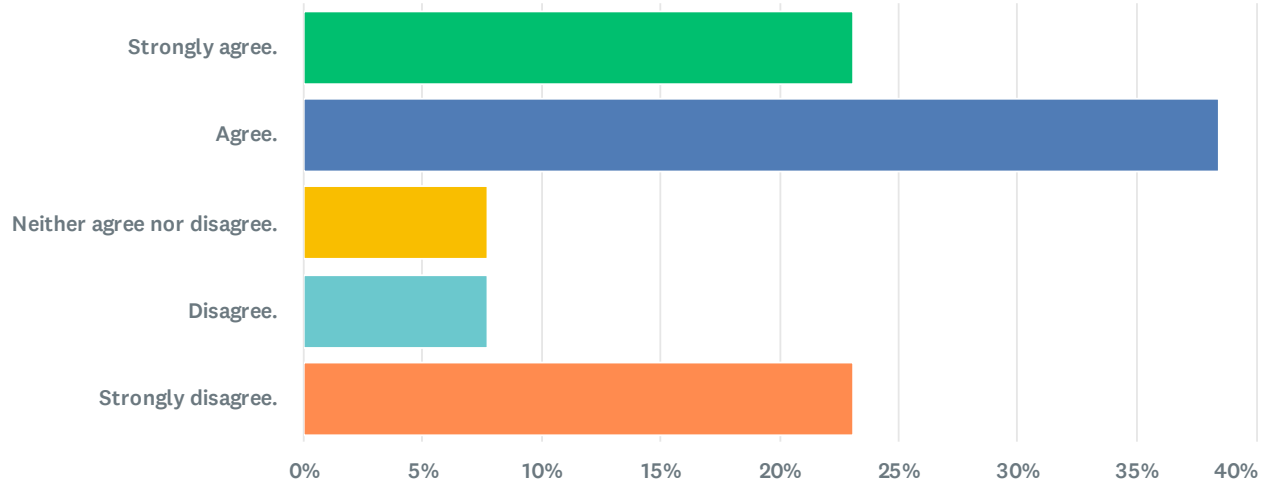

Q4 Saint Cloud Metro Bus is proposing to COMPLETE construction on a western transit center located in Waite Park at the intersection of Sundial Drive and Second Avenue S (near WACOSA). While some initial work has been done on the site, additional funding is needed to complete this project. In total, Metro Bus is anticipating spending \$997,500 in 2026 for construction work on the western transit center. Metro Bus is slated to receive \$798,000 in federal funding to complete this project, with the remaining \$199,500 coming from local funding sources. How do you feel about the proposed change?

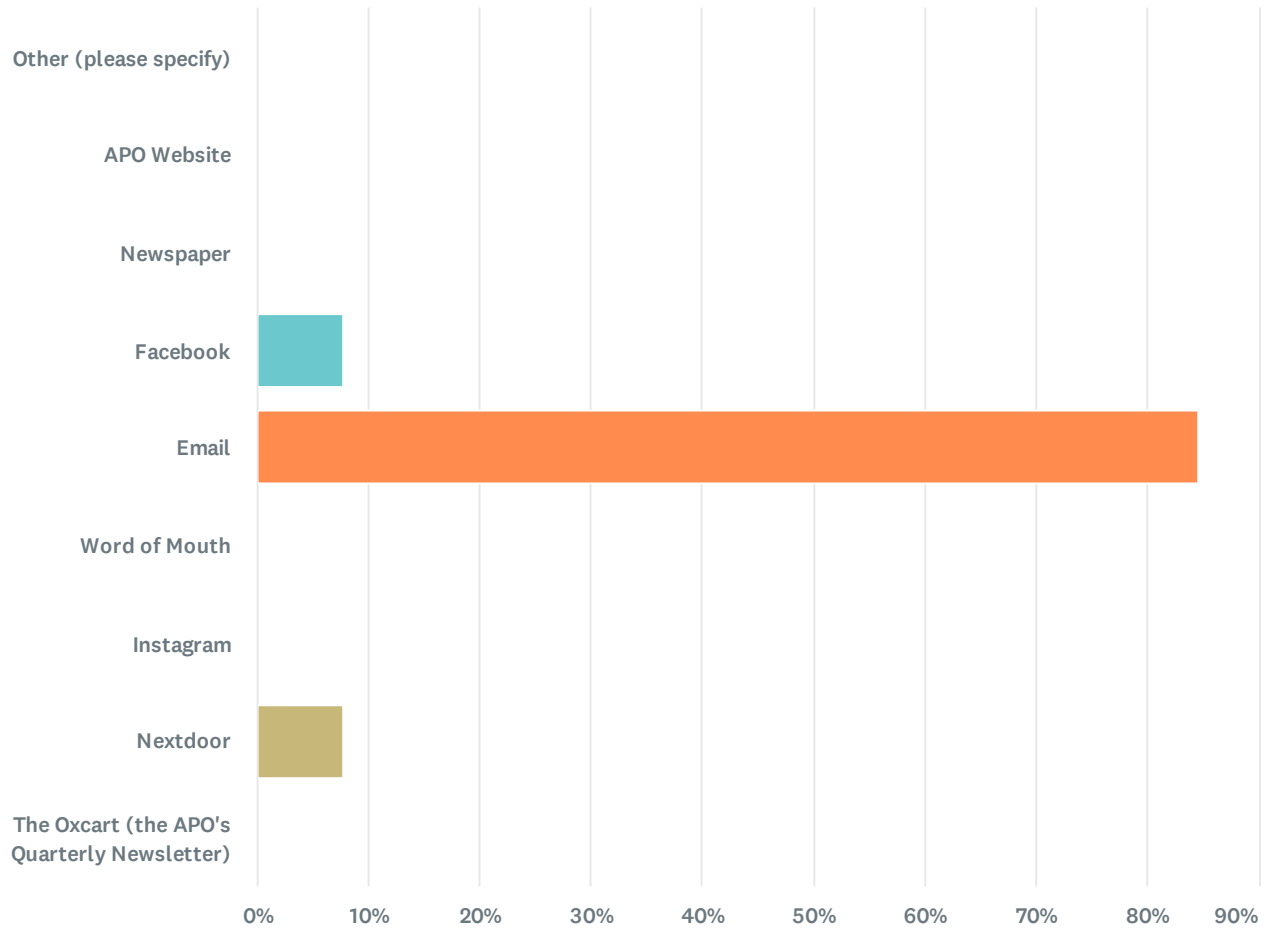

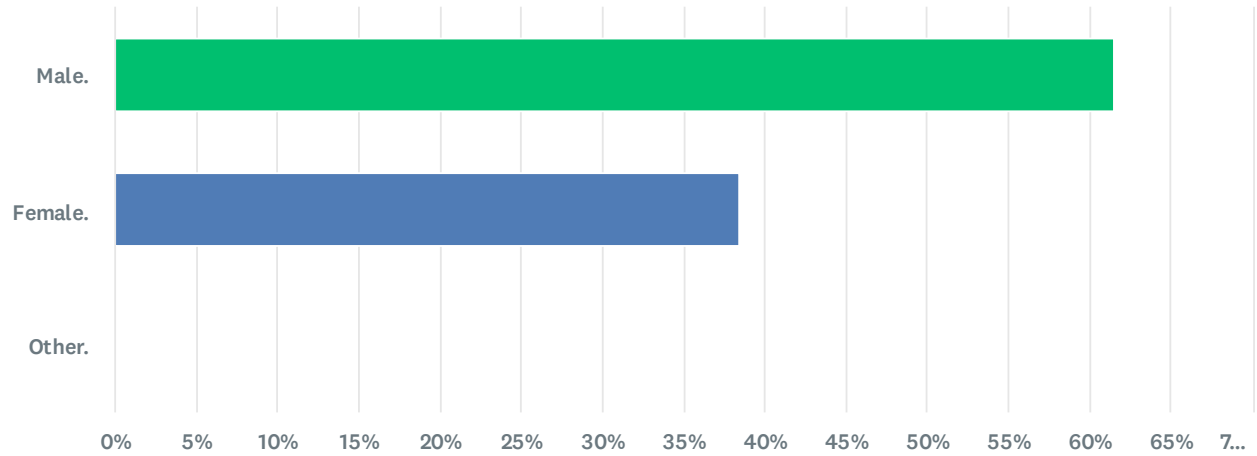

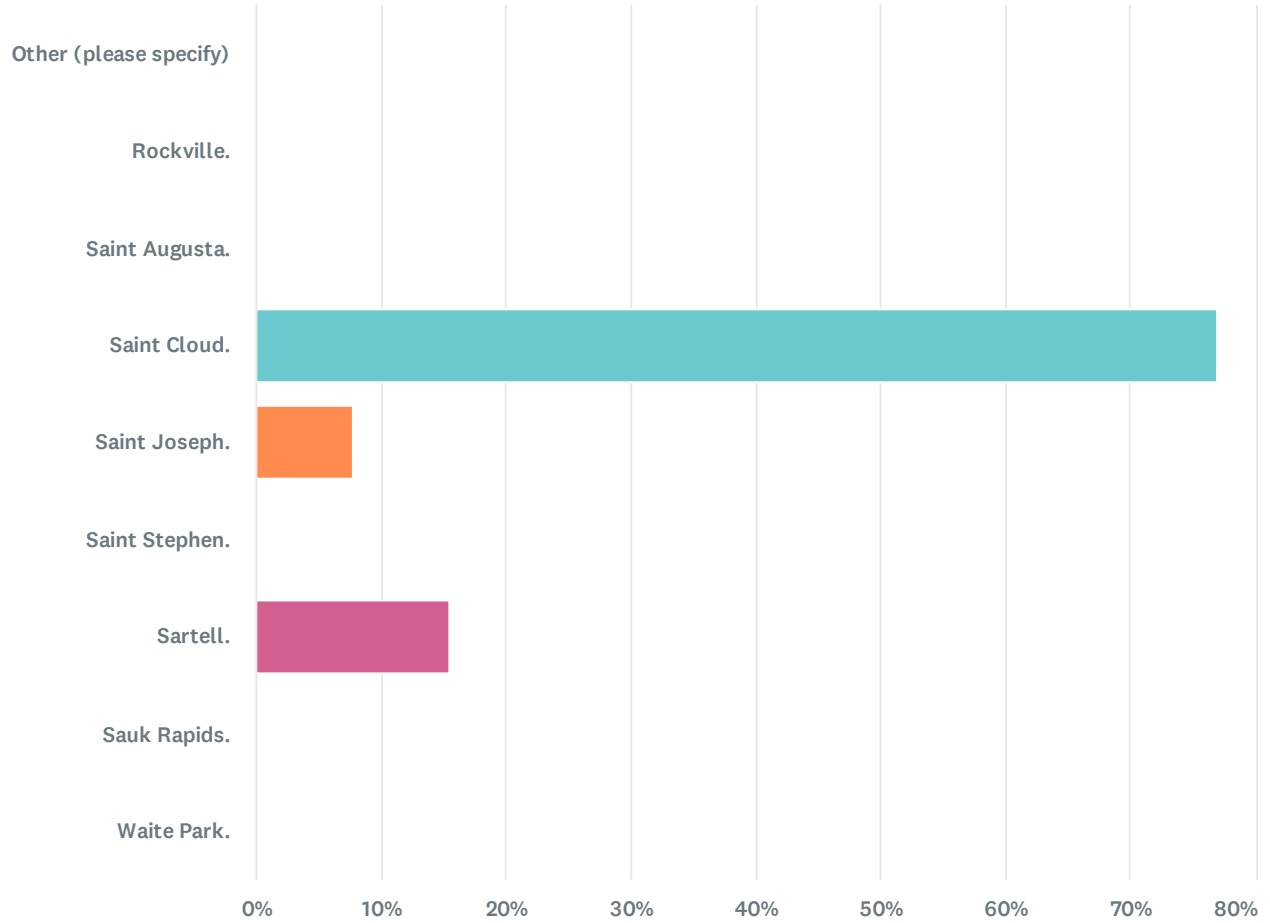
## Q7 What is your gender?

## Q8 In what city do you reside?

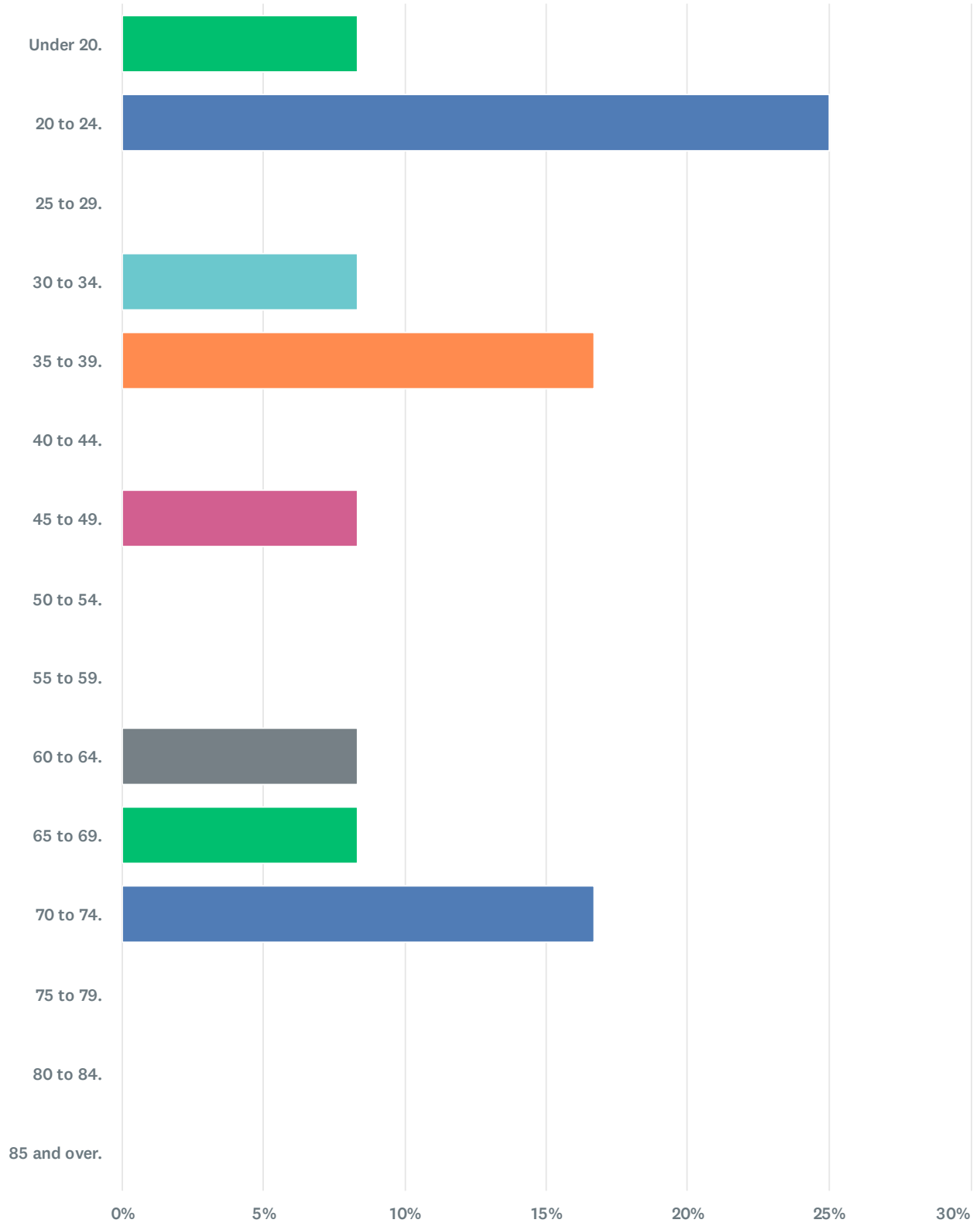

## Q9 What is your age?

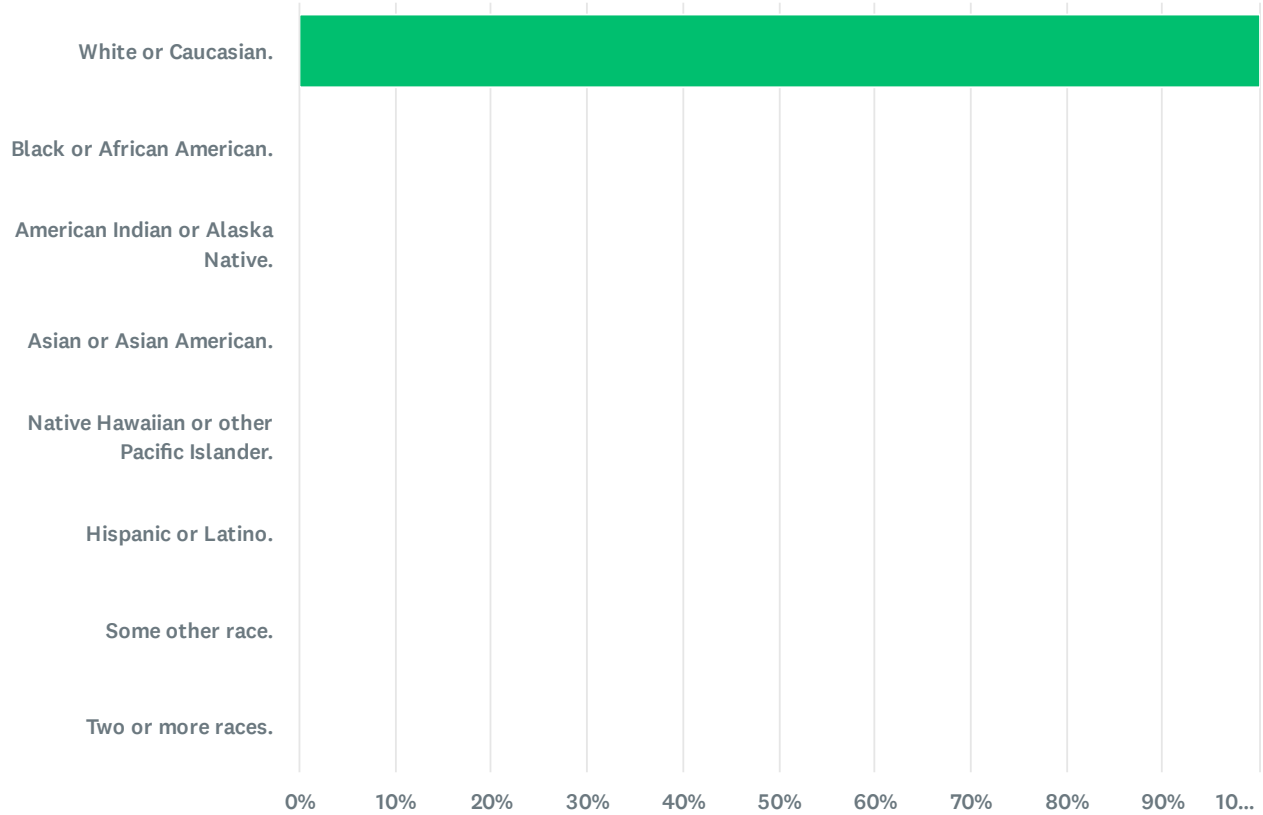

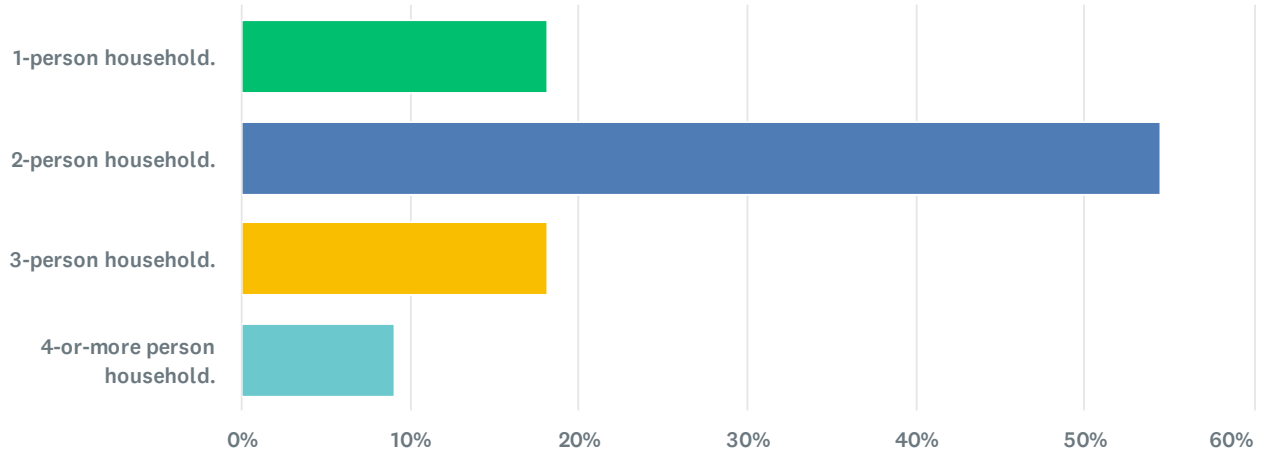
## Q10 With what ethnicity do you most identify?

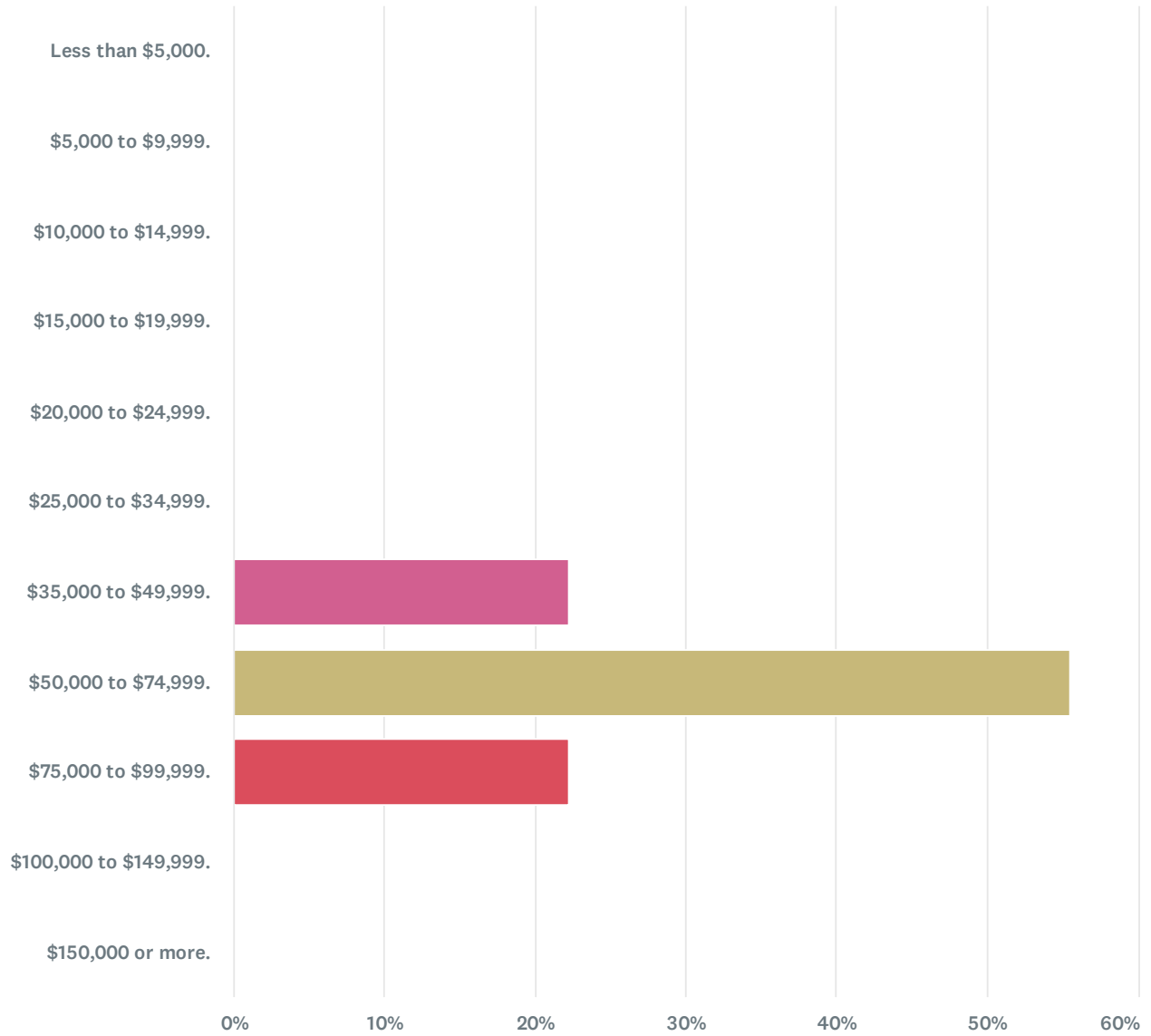
## Q11 How many people live in your household?

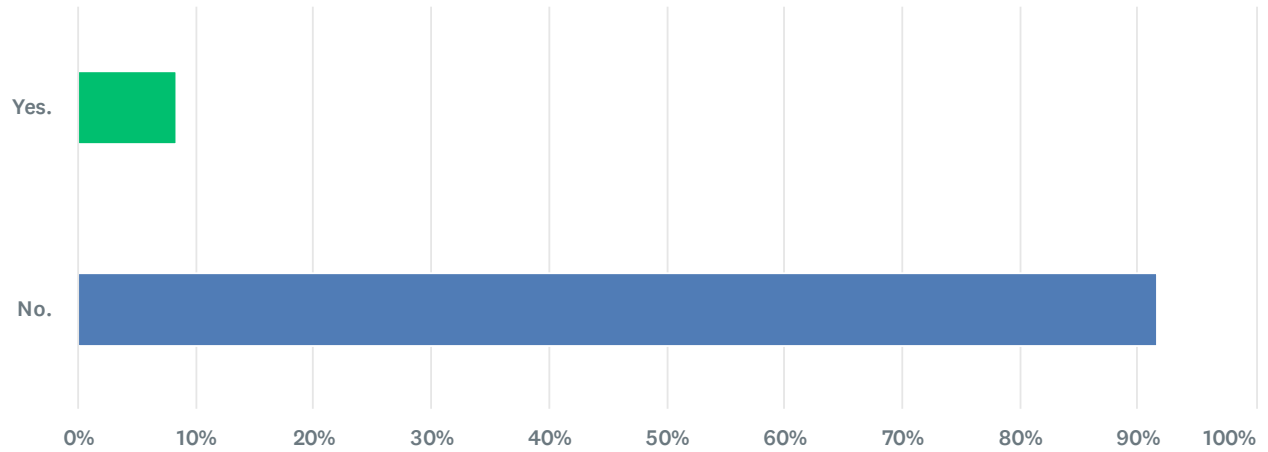
## Q12 What was your total household income last year?

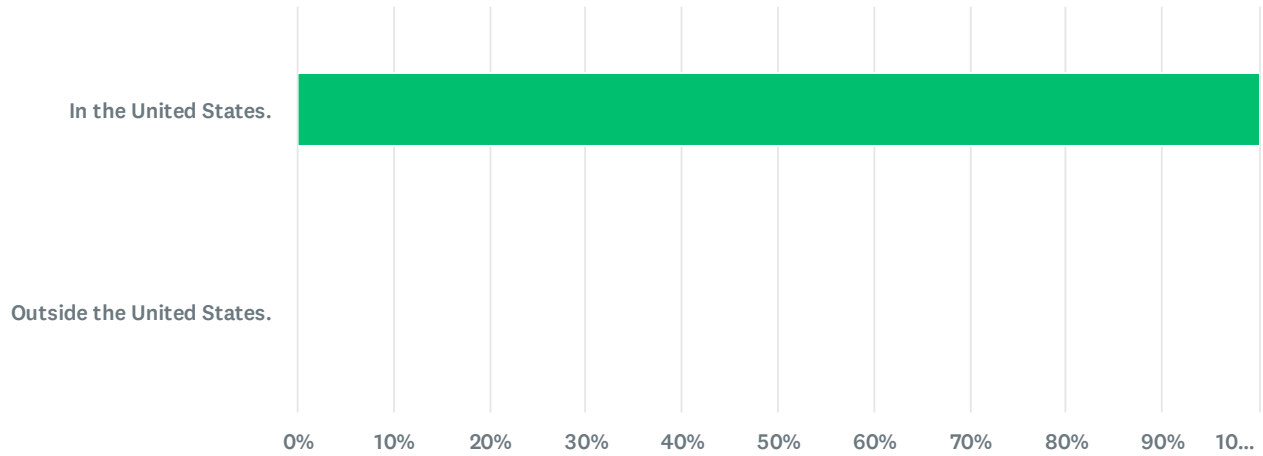
## Q13 Do you have a physical disability?

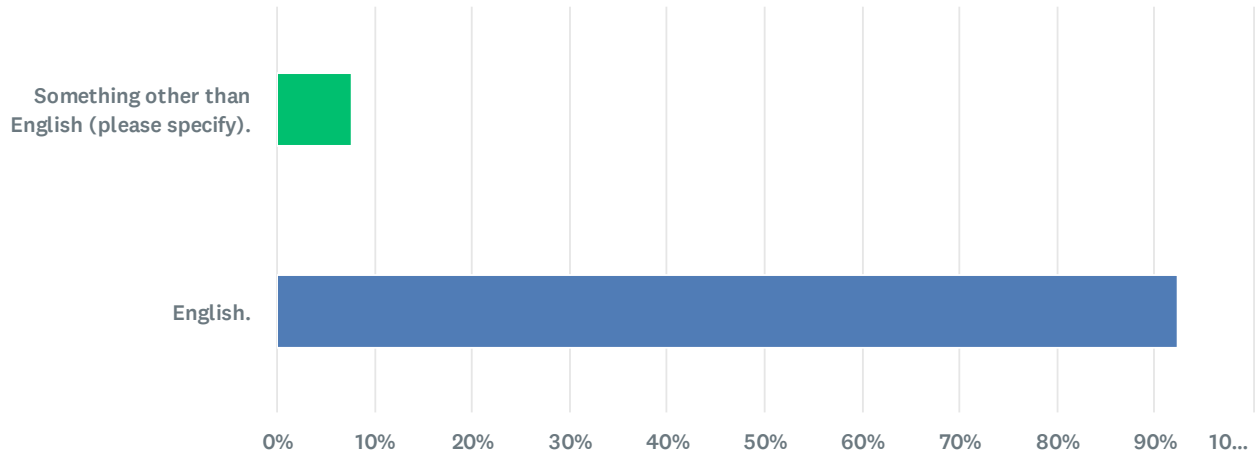
## Q14 Where were you born?
